

## ROW Volunteer Coaching Card

### Generic Praise

Good job!    Nice work!    You did great!

### Specific Feedback

You kept trying until you got it right!

You looked all the way through that word!

#### **Techniques:**

**These practices are used by the teachers.  
Please carry them out as you read with  
your student.**

**TRACKING** - run your finger under words as you read to help the reader stay on track.

**PAUSING FOR PUNCTUATION (., ! ?)** - Punctuation tells the reader where to pause, change or raise his voice.

**VOCAL INFLECTION** - reading with expression, reading at an appropriate pace (slowing down for serious parts and speeding up for exciting parts) can help the reader become faster and smoother.

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<b>Word Attack Strategies: It's always ok to model these for the reader if needed!</b>
<b>STOP if something doesn't look right, sound right, or make sense.</b>
<b>Say the letter sounds and blend them together.</b>
<b>Put your finger under the letters and say the sounds.</b>
<b>Cover up part of the word.</b>
<b>Chunk it! Look for a part you know.</b>
<b>Try a different sound for the vowel.</b>
<b>Go back and reread the sentence to make sure you're right!</b>

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
